RECOMMENDATION:

Give second reading and adopt Ordinance 04-15 - Increasing Salaries of the City Council Members from \$ 828 per month to \$952.

BACKGROUND:

For the November 15th, 2004 City Council meeting, Mayor Monahan requested that staff prepare the necessary documents for City Council consideration of an adjustment to its own compensation. Salaries for members of the City Council were last adjusted in 2002 and are governed by State law. On November 15th, 2004, the City Council gave first reading to Ordinance 04-15. Staff has no additional information for Council to consider at this point in time.

ANALYSIS:

Attached Ordinance 04-15 would allow for an increase of up to a maximum of 15% to the salaries of the City Council that would not go into effect until the new Council terms begin after the next general election in 2006. The new monthly salary for Council members if the ordinance is approved will be \$952 per month.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED:

The alternative would be to not give the second reading to Ordinance 04-15 Increasing Salaries of the City Council Members.

FISCAL REVIEW:

There is no fiscal impact at this point in time. If approved, the salaries of the City Council would not go into effect until the new Council terms begin after the next general election in 2006.

LEGAL REVIEW:

The City Attorney's Office has reviewed the attached documents and, where appropriate, approved them as to form.

CONCLUSION:

Attached Ordinance 04-15 would allow for an increase of up to a maximum of 15% to the salaries of the City Council that would not go into effect until the new Council terms begin after the next general election in 2006. The new monthly salary will be raised to \$952 per month.
