

## COMMITTEE FORMATION APPLICATION

**Proposed Name:** Redevelopment and Residential Rehabilitation Committee

**Task/Objective(s):** Promote community understanding of, and involvement in, the redevelopment of both housing throughout the City and commercial properties within the Redevelopment Project Area. The Committee serves as an Advisory Board to both the Redevelopment Agency and the City Council on housing-related and neighborhood issues. Committee Members provide input on eligible uses of U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG, HOME) and Redevelopment Agency funds.

The Redevelopment Agency adopted, at its May 12, 1997 meeting, and the following Conflict of Interest Statement: Committee members who are affiliated with and/or receive compensation from a nonprofit are prohibited from voting, participating in or discussing matters related to the Community Development Block Grant or HOME grant application process.

Clarification of the Conflict of Interest Statement was provided by the City Attorney and presented to the Redevelopment Agency at the July 14, 1997 meeting.

**Type:** Standing  Ad Hoc

**Proposed Membership:** In the appointment of members, special emphasis is to be placed on equitable representation by business owners / managers and residents within the Redevelopment Project Area. The Committee is made up of eleven (11) members and five (5) alternates. All members' terms are for four (4) years; six (6) members' terms are to expire in odd-numbered years, and five (5) members' terms are to expire in even-numbered years. After serving a four (4) year term, members may re-apply for a two (2) year term. Alternates who are moved to an incumbent's term will fulfill that term and then may reapply for a two (2) year term.

**Proposed Term of Office:** At the July 14, 1997 Redevelopment Agency meeting the following terms were established: six (6) members' terms are to expire in 2001, five (5) members will serve an initial three (3) year term expiring in 2000. All subsequent appointments will be for four (4) year terms. Alternates have no term expiration.
